## **Lizenzbedingungen für die Freeware-Version der Verschlüsselungssoftware „hildeGUARD“ für den Privatgebrauch**

### **1. Geltungsbereich, Vertragsschluss**

1.1 Diese Lizenzbedingungen gelten zwischen dem Lizenznehmer (nachfolgend „Nutzer“) und dem Lizenzgeber, der PROSIS GmbH, Rinnberg 25, 85296 Rohrbach (nachfolgend „PROSIS“) für die Nutzung der Freeware-Version der Verschlüsselungssoftware „hildeGUARD“ (nachfolgend „SOFTWARE“). Durch den Download der SOFTWARE kommt der Nutzungsvertrag unter Geltung dieser Lizenzbedingungen zustande.

1.2 Pro Nutzer ist eine Installation auf einem ausschließlich privat genutzten Endgerät zulässig. Die Nutzung darf ausschließlich zu eigenen privaten Zwecken erfolgen. Nutzungsberechtigt sind daher nur Verbraucher; Verbraucher im Sinne dieser Lizenzbedingungen ist jede natürliche Person, die ein Rechtsgeschäft zu einem Zwecke abschließt, der weder ihrer gewerblichen noch ihrer selbständigen beruflichen Tätigkeit zugerechnet werden kann (vgl. § 13 BGB). Mit dem Download erklärt der Nutzer, dass er als Verbraucher handelt.

### **2. Vertragsgegenstand, unentgeltliche Überlassung der SOFTWARE an Verbraucher**

2.1 Bei der SOFTWARE handelt es sich um eine Standard-Software von PROSIS zum Verschlüsseln von Dateien, die darüber hinaus bei Bedarf mit anderen hildeGUARD Anwendern sicher ausgetauscht werden können. Eine Beschreibung des Produkts einschließlich der maximalen Anzahl möglicher Schlüssel sowie die technischen Voraussetzungen sind abrufbar auf der Homepage von PROSIS unter <https://hildeGUARD.prosis.de>. Ist nichts anderes angegeben, können maximal drei Schlüssel vom Nutzer genutzt werden. Ein verwalteter Schlüssel ist hier immer lediglich der Public-Key. Der dazugehörige Private-Key bleibt beim Anwender selbst und wird nicht ausgetauscht.

2.2 Die SOFTWARE wird dem Nutzer in der Freeware-Version unentgeltlich überlassen. Es gelten die Regelungen zur Schenkung (§§ 516 ff BGB).



2.3 Eine Verwendung durch den Nutzer erfolgt in dessen eigener Verantwortung. Auch die Einhaltung der Systemvoraussetzungen sowie eine ordnungsgemäße, regelmäßige Datensicherung obliegen dem Nutzer. Die Schlüssel werden erst nach der Installation beim Nutzer von diesem in der SOFTWARE hinterlegt. Das bedeutet, dass ausschließlich der Nutzer selbst im Besitz der Schlüssel ist. Es wird darauf hingewiesen, dass verschlüsselte Dateien ausschließlich mit dem jeweiligen Schlüssel entschlüsselbar sind, die im Rahmen der Nutzung generiert werden und PROSIS nicht vorliegen. Es wird daher empfohlen, zur Datensicherung ein Backup der unverschlüsselten Dateien auf einem anderen Datenträger zu hinterlegen.

2.4 Die SOFTWARE wird im Objektcode überlassen. Der Quellcode ist nicht Teil der überlassenen SOFTWARE. Sie ist in deutscher Sprache verfügbar.

### **3. Nutzungsrechtseinräumung**

3.1 PROSIS räumt dem Nutzer das nicht-ausschließliche (einfache), nicht unterlizenzierbare, zeitlich unbeschränkte Recht ein, die SOFTWARE zu eigenen privaten Zwecken bestimmungsgemäß mit der maximal vereinbarten Anzahl an Schlüsseln zu nutzen, das heißt insbesondere dauerhaft oder temporär zu speichern und zu laden, sie anzuzeigen und ablaufen zu lassen, auch soweit hierfür Vervielfältigungen notwendig werden.

Jeder Nutzer ist nur einmal zum Download der SOFTWARE berechtigt. Sie darf pro Nutzer einmal auf einem Endgerät installiert werden (Einzelplatznutzung). Dabei muss es sich um ein ausschließlich privat genutztes Endgerät handeln. Wechselt der Nutzer das Endgerät, muss er die SOFTWARE von dem bisher verwendeten Endgerät löschen. Eine zeitgleiche Mehrfachnutzung oder die Nutzung per Datenfernübertragung ist nicht zulässig.

Die Nutzung darf ausschließlich zu eigenen privaten Zwecken erfolgen. Die maximal zulässige Anzahl gleichzeitig aktivierter Schlüssel darf nicht überschritten werden. Ist nichts anderes vereinbart, dürfen pro Nutzer maximal drei Schlüssel genutzt werden.

3.2 Ein Vertrieb, eine Vermietung oder Unterlizenzierung der SOFTWARE ist nicht zulässig. Auch eine sonstige Zurverfügungstellung an Dritte ist nicht zulässig.



3.3 Urheberrechts- und sonstige Schutzrechtsvermerke sowie der Identifizierung der SOFTWARE dienende Merkmale dürfen weder entfernt noch verändert werden, auch nicht für eine Kopie der SOFTWARE. Der Nutzer ist ausschließlich zu Sicherungszwecken, die für die künftige vertragsgemäße Benutzung erforderlich sind, berechtigt, eine Kopie der SOFTWARE zu erstellen.

3.4 Ein Bearbeitungsrecht wird nicht eingeräumt, es sei denn, Änderungen sind nach zwingenden gesetzlichen Vorschriften zulässig. Die Rückübersetzung des Objektcodes in andere Codeformen (Dekompilierung) sowie sonstige Arten der Rückerschließung der verschiedenen Herstellungsstufen der SOFTWARE (z.B. Reverse Engineering, Reassembling) sind ausschließlich im Rahmen des § 69e Urheberrechtsgesetz zulässig.

3.5 Eine über diese Lizenzbedingungen hinausgehende Rechtseinräumung ist mit der Überlassung der SOFTWARE nicht verbunden. PROSIS behält sich insbesondere die Verbreitungs-, Ausstellungs-, Vorführungs-, Aufführungs- und Veröffentlichungsrechte vor.

3.6 Besondere Bedingungen für im Rahmen der SOFTWARE-Überlassung mitüberlassene Drittsoftware (Software, die nicht von PROSIS entwickelt wurde, z.B. Open Source Software): Für Drittsoftware gelten deren jeweilige Bedingungen. Für diese ist Vertragssprache Englisch, sofern nicht anders angegeben. Eine Liste der Drittsoftware findet sich in beigefügter Anlage. Für diese gelten die dort benannten Lizenzbedingungen. Den Quellcode von Open Source Software stellt PROSIS auf Anfrage zur Verfügung, sofern von den jeweiligen Lizenzbedingungen gefordert.

#### **4. Mangelhaftung**

Die SOFTWARE wird unentgeltlich überlassen. Für Sach- und Rechtsmängel haftet PROSIS daher nicht, es sei denn es liegt arglistiges Verschweigen eines Mangels vor. Es gelten §§ 523, 524 BGB.

#### **5. Haftung**

Für Schadens- und Aufwendungsersatzansprüche des Nutzers - gleich aus welchem Rechtsgrund, etwa aufgrund vertraglicher Pflichtverletzungen oder unerlaubter Handlung - gelten die gesetzlichen Bestimmungen, insbesondere § 521 BGB. PROSIS haftet lediglich für Vorsatz und grobe Fahrlässigkeit.



Haftet PROSIS danach für den Verlust von Daten, ist die Haftung auf die Höhe des Aufwandes beschränkt, der für die Wiederherstellung dieser Daten anfällt, wenn Sicherheitskopien erstellt wurden. Dem Nutzer obliegt die Verpflichtung, regelmäßige Datensicherungen der unverschlüsselten Dateien nach dem Stand der Technik durchzuführen.

## **6. Schlussbestimmungen**

6.1 Vertragssprache ist deutsch. Es gilt das Recht der Bundesrepublik Deutschland mit Ausnahme dessen kollisionsrechtlicher Bestimmungen für alle Streitigkeiten zwischen dem Kunden und PROSIS in Bezug auf die Produkte oder im Zusammenhang mit diesen. Die Bestimmungen des Übereinkommens der Vereinten Nationen über Verträge über den internationalen Warenverkauf vom 11. April 1980 (CISG) sind ausdrücklich ausgeschlossen. Bei Verbrauchern gilt diese Rechtswahl jedoch nur insoweit, als nicht der gewährte Schutz durch zwingende Bestimmungen des Rechts des Staates, in dem der Verbraucher seinen gewöhnlichen Aufenthalt hat, entzogen wird.

6.2 Ist der Nutzer entgegen den Bestimmungen dieser Vereinbarung Kaufmann, juristische Person des öffentlichen Rechts oder öffentlich-rechtliches Sondervermögen, ist Erfüllungsort und ausschließlicher Gerichtsstand für alle Streitigkeiten aus und in Zusammenhang mit diesem Vertrag der Sitz von PROSIS.
